History

The past situation:

- Nobody who tries to ensure that a Warpstock Europe happens
- No public status reports
- Nobody steps forward at first, then last-minute effort
- No organisation infrastructure
 - No information resources
 - No communication infrastructure
 - No presentation infrastructure

Results

Each year, organisers have to start from scratch:

- Find out how to do things themselves
- Search for knowledge bearers
- Communication facilities have to be set up
- Web site has to be set up
- Info and PR material has to be written

Results - 2

Corollary

- *Knowledge gets lost*
- *Much time is spent on re-inventing the wheel*
- *High stress level for organisers*

D'oh!

- Suboptimal experience for organisers and visitors
- Reluctance to organise (another) event

Remedy

Theorem (Solution)

- *Create lasting infrastructure*
- *Reduce workload*
- *Create awareness*

Provide:

- Library with information about organising an event
- Communication facilities
- Presentation facilities
- Public status report

Background

We use:

- TYPO3 web application server
- Professional hosting on Linux/Unix
- Several extensions
- E-mail IMAP accounts

Presentation Facilities

Feature:

- Extensible CMS
- Design templates
- User administration
- Rich text editing
- Localisation facilities
- News system
- Event management system
- Workflow

Corollary

- *Work can be distributed (roles)*
- *No in-depth skills required for most roles*

Information Library

Contains:

- Wiki to collect information and develop documents
- Download area for documents and sheets
- Database of
 - knowledge bearers
 - speakers
 - companies
 - locations

Organisation and Communication Facilities

Feature:

- IMAP e-mail accounts
- Concept wiki
- Forum
- To-do list / project management
- Calendar
